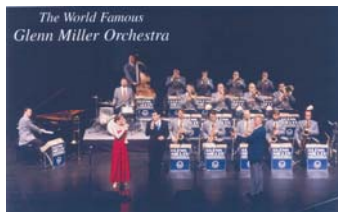

CONCERTS AND EVENTS

The Gold Coast Jazz Society has a mainstage jazz concert series featuring world-class national and local jazz artists. Concerts are held at the Amaturio Theater of the Broward Center for the Performing Arts. Full and Sampler subscriptions are available through the Gold Coast Jazz office. Single tickets are sold through the Broward Center for the Performing Arts. Top name jazz and big band artists have appeared including Bill Charlap, Dick Hyman, the Glenn Miller Orchestra, the Four Freshman, the Woody Herman Orchestra, Bill Allred, and Cyrus Chestnut as well as local artists.



JAZZ EDUCATION & OUTREACH FOR ALL AGES

In-school & SEAS performances & Jazz Jams

Each year, elementary, middle and high school students attend live jazz education performances. The programs for elementary school students, *Jazz is Elementary* and *JazzSLAM* takes jazz performances to local elementary schools to introduce students to classic jazz and to help students learn FCAT skills through music. *The Facets of Jazz*, a program designed for middle and high school students, affords them an opportunity to hear a live jazz performance at the Amaturio Theater of the Broward Center for the Performing Arts. Other educational and outreach opportunities include master classes for high school students, *Jazz for Wee Ones* for Pre-K children and *First Friday Jazz Jams* for jazz students.



Jeanette M. Russell Jazz Scholarships

The annual Jeanette M. Russell Jazz Scholarship Competition provides an opportunity for deserving students to compete for jazz scholarships for college and summer jazz camps. Over \$200,000 in scholarship funds have been distributed to worthy students studying jazz since 2002.

Members and friends are invited to various events and activities throughout the year such as the annual Jazz Gala, Jazz Cabarets, the "Jazz Stars of Tomorrow" Jazz Scholarship Reception, and other fun member socials.



GOLD COAST JAZZ SOCIETY BAND

This fully professional band, under the direction of Eric Allison, not only performs on the main stage jazz concert series, but also provides the organization's education and outreach performances. The band has performed concerts for many local organizations and is available for booking for a concert series, events and special occasions.
